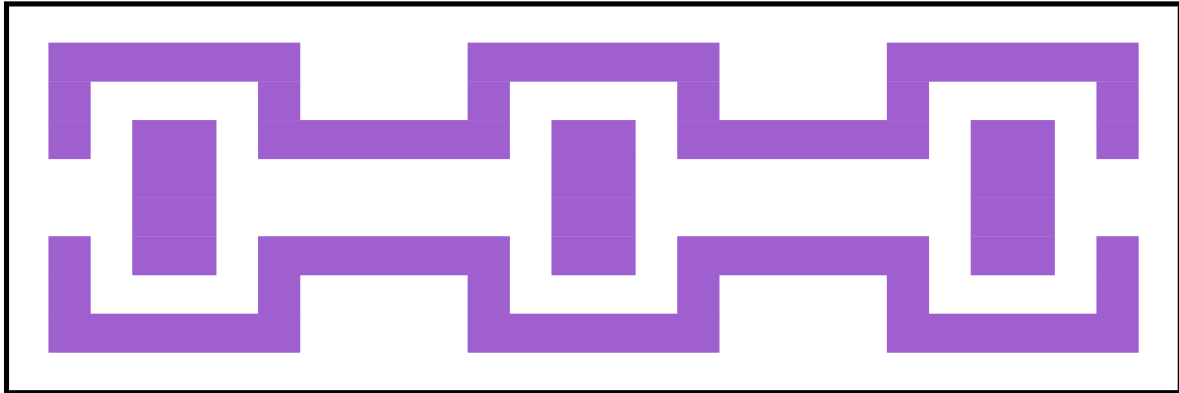


Geometric Design - Block of the Quarter 2021



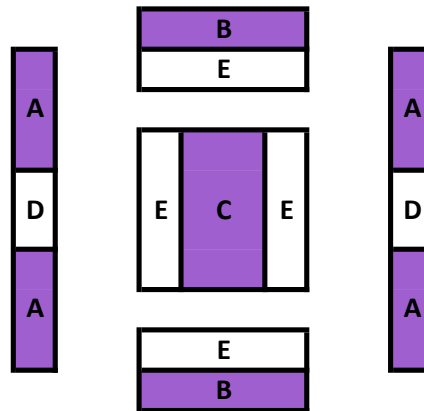
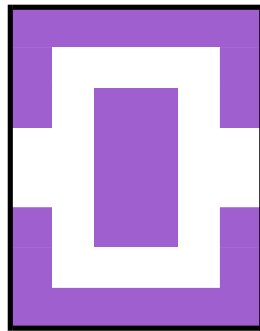
Purple Cut List

- A 2.5" x 6.5" (need 12)
- B 2.5" x 8.5" (need 10)
- C 4.5" x 8.5" (need 3)

White Cut List

- D 2.5" x 4.5" (need 6)
- E 2.5" x 8.5" (need 12)
- F 4.5" x 8.5" (need 6)
- G 2.5" x 160" pieced strips to create border around entire row (section 1, 2, 1, 2, 1)

Section 1 - Three Total



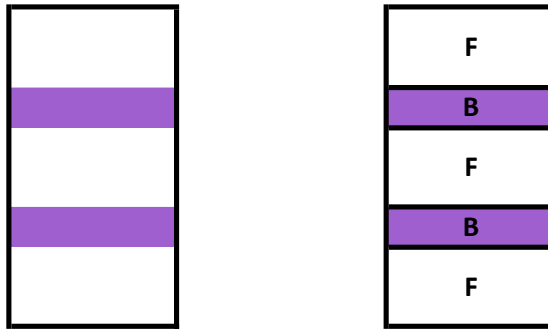
One Block at a Time Instructions

- 1 Sew two E's to C - press all seams to dark
- 2 Sew two B's to two E's
- 3 Sew BE units to ECE unit
- 4 Sew four A's to two D's
- 5 Sew ADA units to middle unit

Section 1 Chain Piecing Instructions for Efficiency

- 1 Sew one E to each of three C's
- 2 Sew six B's to six E's
- 3 Sew six A's to six D's
- 4 Press seams to dark
- 5 Sew three E's on other side of three EC units (to make ECE)
- 6 Sew six A's to the six D's of AD unit (to make ADA)
- 7 Press seams to dark
- 8 Sew one BE unit to each of three ECE units (E next to ECE)
- 9 Press seams toward ECE
- 10 Sew one BE unit to opposite end of three ECE/BE units
- 11 Press seams toward ECE
- 12 Sew ADA unit to one side of the three ECE/BE/BE units
- 13 Press seams toward ADA
- 14 Sew ADA unit to other side of the three BE/ECE/BE units
- 15 Press seams toward ADA

Section 2 - Two Total



One Block at a Time Instructions

- 1 Sew two F's to two B's
- 2 Sew BF units to one F
- 3 Sew section 1 to section 2 - pin where B's on section 2 will line up with A's from section 1.

Section 2 Chain Piecing Instructions

- 1 Sew four F's to four B's
- 2 Press seams to dark
- 3 Sew two FB units to other two FB units (to give FBFB)
- 4 Press seams to dark
- 5 Sew two remaining F's to FBFB (to give FBFBF)

Make Row & Add Border

- 1 Sew section 1 to section 2 x2
Tip: Pin where B's on section 2 line up with A's from section 1 (see yellow below)
- 2 Press towards section 1's
- 3 Sew last section 1 to end
- 4 Press towards section 1's
- 5 Attach border around whole row
