While St. Jude's does not have a quilt size requirement, we try to follow these guidelines: (i) Baby: 36" x 48"; (ii) Throw: 48" x 60"; and (iii) Hospital: 36" x 84".

You may work individually or collaboratively with other members. Quilts are due at the November meeting. All challenges completed will be entered into a prize drawing!





On a scale of 1 to 9, what did you think of the pacing of the challenges this year? 6 responses




On a scale of 1 to 9, how important is it to you to have prizes for each challenge? 8 responses




## **Community Outreach**


Did you make any pillowcases for North Alabama Foster Closet in 2023? 8 responses



### **DEAI**


On a scale of 1 to 9, how much do you agree with the statement "I understand how to report issues to the DEAI committee."

On a scale of 1 to 9, how much do you agree with the statement "Should I have or witness an issue, I feel comfortable reporting it to the DEAI committee."




### **Membership**

On a scale of 1 to 9, how much value do you feel that you get from being a member of the national MQG?



How often do you use the website?




On a scale of 1 to 9, with 5 being "just right", how well did you feel that the officers communicated with the guild this year?


