

I Heart You

2021 Block of the Quarter

Fabric Choice:

Choose two kid friendly fabrics. One block needs no more than two fat quarters.

Fabric One Cut List:

- A. Heart – cut four $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$
- B. Accent Square – cut one $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$

Fabric Two Cut List:

- C. Small Snowball Corners – cut four $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1\frac{3}{4}''$
- D. Large Snowball Corners – cut two $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$
- E. Wide Borders – cut two $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$
- F. Narrow Short Border – cut one $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 11\frac{1}{4}''$
- G. Narrow Long Border – cut one $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$



Instructions:

1. Mark diagonals from corner to corner on four C's (Small Snowball Corners) and two D's (Large Snowball Corners). See picture 1.

2. Put the four C's in the upper corners of two A's orienting the lines to create the top of the heart.
See picture 1.
3. Put two remaining A's and two D's right sides together. See picture 1.
4. Sew along all drawn diagonal lines.
5. Cut off excess triangles of fabric. See pictures 2 & 3.

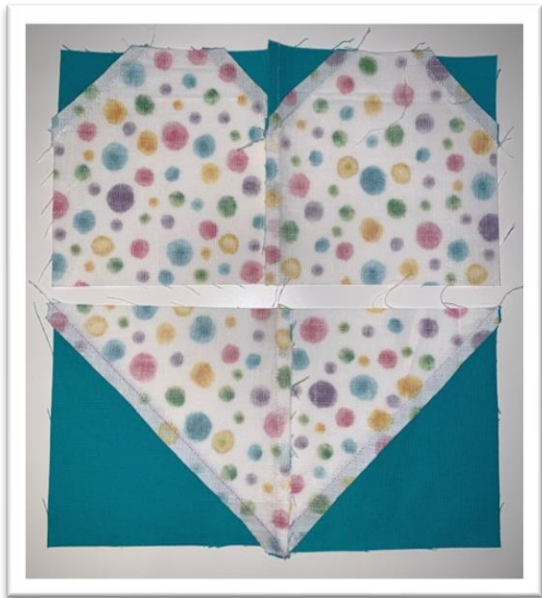

6. Press open all snowballed corners. There will be less bulk if you iron these seams open. See picture 4.

7. Sew two ACC's together to create the top of the heart. Press seam to left. See picture 5.

8. Sew two AD's together to create the bottom of the heart. Press seam to right. See picture 5.

9. Sew top half of the heart to the bottom half of the heart. Seams should lock in middle. Your heart will measure $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$. See picture 6.

10. Sew one E (Wide Border) to the right of the heart. Press. See picture 7 for border layout.

11. Sew remaining E to B (Accent Square). Press. See picture 7.
12. Sew EB to bottom of the heart. Press. See picture 7.
13. Sew F (Narrow Short Border) to left of heart. Press. See picture 7.
14. Sew G (Narrow Long Border) to top off heart. Press. See picture 7.

15. Finished block will be 12 ½" x 12 ½". See picture 8, 9 & 10.
