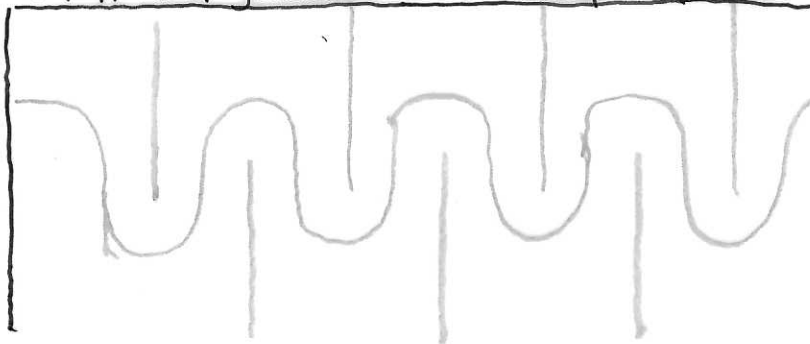


# ALLOVER FEATHERS

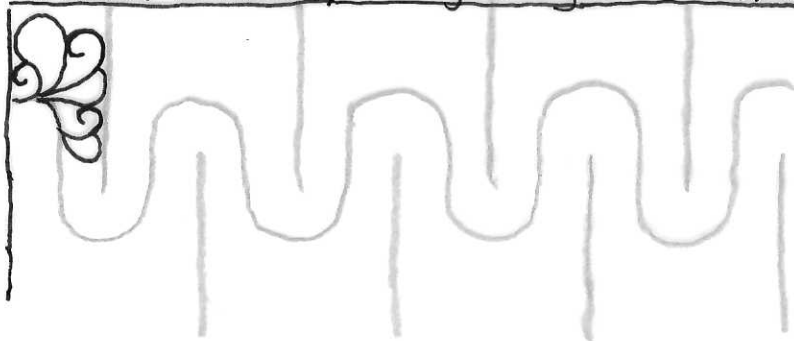
This design requires marking, whether with chalk or blue pen.

First, draw an S-curve, really large...  
Then add guidelines halfway between curves



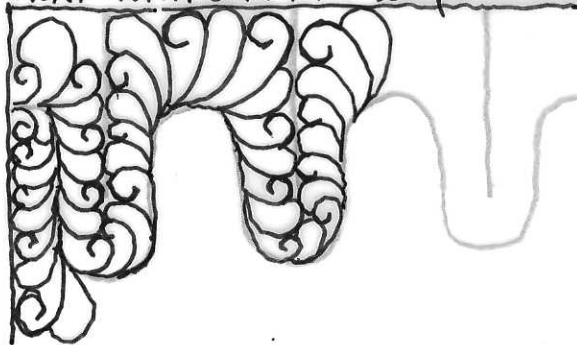
Now you're ready to quilt!

Start with a small curl, and stretch your feathers around to meet your edges + guidelines. Big fat feathers are easiest!



Now for that tight inside curve!

Go ahead as you normally would, touching your guidelines with your feather tops. When you reach the curve bottom, just fill the next with one that wraps around. OR fill the space with a couple of mini feathers.



When you get to the end, tie off and start again on the other side.

This is supposed to be wild, so don't worry about making your feathers regular. It turns out with great texture in the end.
