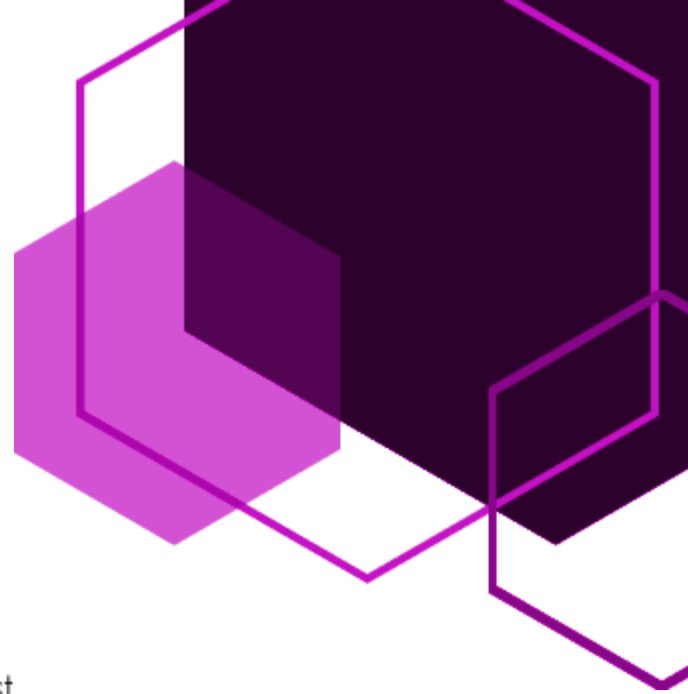
Elections are approaching. Are you interested in a leadership role? If you have questions, please inquire via email. All members are eligible.
